In accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Larry Chesney moved to approve the agenda of January 9, 2020, as written. The motion, seconded by Tim Simpson, passed unanimously.

7. Project Review Items

A. Tentative Parcel Map Case Number WTPM19-0020 (Melarkey Pacel Map) — For possible action, hearing, and discussion to approve a tentative parcel map dividing a ±5.004 acre parcel into two (2) parcels of ±2.5 acres in size.

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Eric Young opened the public hearing. Chris Bronczyk reviewed his staff report dated December 23, 2019. Mr. Bronczyk noted, the Southwest Truckee Meadows Area Plan requires NDOW be sent the application for review. The application was sent but no comments or conditions were received from NDOW. He also noted, CFA, Inc., the applicant's representative, contacted Washoe County Engineering in protest to condition 2(f). Engineering staff did submit a change to condition 2(f).

With no response to the call for public comment, the public comment period was closed.

Tim Simpson asked for clarification to the new condition language; "In addition, the parcel map shall grant an access easement over Parcel 1 for the benefit of Parcel 2." Wayne Handrock said it is not currently being shown but needs to be added. It currently has the 33-foot easements on the sidelines which were originally from the government patents and there is litigation that makes their status on the "iffy" side. The language is just trying to cover all bases.

Tim Simpson moved that, after giving reasoned consideration to the information contained within the staff report and the information received during the public meeting, that the Washoe County Parcel Map Review Committee approve Parcel Map Case Number WTPM19-0020 for Rosemary Melarkey, subject to the conditions of approval included as Exhibit A with the staff report, and make the determination that the following criteria is or will be adequately provided for pursuant to Washoe County Code, Section 110.606.30, along with the amended condition of approval 2(f). Larry Chesney seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

The motion carried and considered the following criteria:

1) General improvement considerations for all parcel maps including, but not limited to:

- a) Environmental and health laws and regulations concerning water and air pollution, the disposal of solid waste, facilities to supply water, community or public sewage disposal and, where applicable, individual systems for sewage disposal;
- b) The availability of water which meets applicable health standards and is sufficient for the reasonably foreseeable needs of the subdivision;
- c) The availability and accessibility of utilities;
- d) The availability and accessibility of public services such as schools, police and fire protection, transportation, recreation and parks;
- e) Conformity with the zoning ordinances and master plan;
- f) General conformity with the governing body's master plan of streets and highways;
- g) The effect of the proposed subdivision on existing public streets and the need for new streets or highways to serve the subdivision;
- h) Physical characteristics of the land such as floodplain, slope and soil;
- The recommendations and comments of those entities reviewing the tentative parcel map pursuant to NRS 278.330 and 278.348, inclusive;
- j) The availability and accessibility of fire protection including, but not limited to, the availability and accessibility of water and services for the prevention and containment of fires including fires in wild lands;
- k) Community antenna television (CATV) conduit and pull wire; and
- I) Recreation and trail easements.
