ORDINANCE SAGE HEN.

On motion duly seconded and carried by the unanimous vote of the board, it was ordered that the following ordinance be adopted and printed in the Reno Evening Gazette, to-wit:

SPECIAL ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CLOSED SEASON ON SAGE-HEN, SAGE-COCK, AND PRAIRIE CHICKEN, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, DO ORDAIN:

SEC. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm, company, corporation or association within the County of Washoe, State of Nevada, to take, kill, catch, trap, net, pound, weir, wound or pursue with attempt to take, catch, capture, injure or destroy any sage-hen or sage-cock, or prairie chicken, at any time except between the 16th day of July and 31st day of July, both dates included, in each and every year, and except between the 16th day of August and the 31st day of August, both dates included, in each and every year.

SEC. 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or more than Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), or by imprisonment in the County Jail of Washoe County, Nevada, for a term of not less than Twenty-five days (25) or more than one hundred and twenty-five days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the 1st day of

A. L. Lewis made application for a permit to run a stage line from Gerlach to the Nevada California State line to Eagleville. No action taken.


