

V. FIRE PREVENTION AND CIVIL DEFENSEORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT FIRES BY REASON OF
LIGHTED CIGARETTES, CIGARS, MATCHES, OR ASHES.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Willful or negligent discarding of burning cigarettes, matches. It shall be unlawful for any person to, either willfully or negligently, throw or place any lighted cigarette, cigar, match, or ashes in any place where such lighted cigarette, cigar, match or ashes may cause a fire.

Section 2. Throwing burning material from moving vehicle. It shall be unlawful for any person to, either willfully or negligently, throw or place from a moving vehicle any lighted cigarette, cigar, match or ashes which may cause a fire.

Section 3. Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$15 nor more than \$500, or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 6 months, or by both fine and imprisonment.
