VII. SAFETY, MORALS AND WELFARE

ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF ANY GUN, PISTOL OR OTHER FIREARM IN OR UPON ANY COUNTY ROAD OR HIGHWAY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Unlawful discharge of firearms on county roads. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any gun, pistol or other firearm in or upon or across any of the county roads or highways; provided that nothing herein shall apply to any sheriff, deputy sheriff, policeman, any county, state or federal game warden, or other peace officer, who shall discharge any pistol or firearm in the lawful exercise of his duties of his office.

Section 2. Penalty. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in the sum of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not to exceed 6 months, or by both fine and imprisonment.
