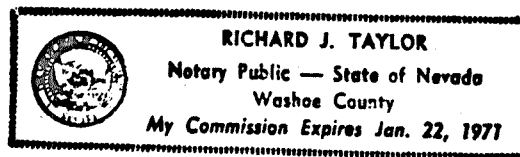

SUMMARY: An Ordinance amending Ordinance 53, Section 4, sub-section 4, Paragraph 2, to add U.S. Interstate 80 to exceptions listed in Section 4, sub-section 4, Paragraph 2.

BILL NO. 181

ORDINANCE NO. 53

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4, SUB-SECTION 4, PARAGRAPH 2, ORDINANCE 53 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PLACEMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF OUTDOOR ADVERTISING STRUCTURES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION THEREOF, THE LICENSING OF FIRMS AND INDIVIDUALS WHO CONSTRUCT AND/OR PLACE ADVERTISING DISPLAYS, THE ESTABLISHMENT AND COLLECTION OF FEES; FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 4, sub-section 4, Paragraph 2, of County Ordinance 53 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 2. On any highways or roadways in the unincorporated areas of Washoe County other than the following:
  - (a) US Highway 40, US Interstate 80, US Highway 395; and any alternates of these routes; or Nevada State Routes 27 and 28, 34, 17, or by whatever names the above-mentioned highways or roadways shall become known at any time in the future.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby find and declare that an emergency does exist, and, consequently, final action shall be taken immediately, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by N.R.S. §244.100.
