**NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE**  
Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 283, amending Exhibit "A" of Ordinance No. 83, entitled "An ordinance regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area and maintenance of buildings or structures in the unincorporated area of Washoe County; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; providing penalties for the violation thereof and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith; and other matters properly relating thereto," as amended, by adding minimum burn-through times for interior wall finishes for group M and I occupancies, was adopted on April 5, 1972 by Commissioners Pagni, Coppa Nelson, Gusk, and McKissick all voting aye.

**SUMMARY:** Amends Ordinance No. 83 (Building Code) to add minimum burn-through times for interior wall finishes for Group H and I occupancies.

ORDINANCE NO. 83

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND EXHIBIT "A" OF WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 83 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVERSION, DEMOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFOR; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO," AS AMENDED, BY ADDING MINIMUM BURN-THROUGH TIMES FOR INTERIOR WALL FINISHES FOR GROUP H AND I OCCUPANCIES.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

**SECTION 1.**

There is hereby added to Exhibit "A" of Washoe County Ordinance No. 83 a new paragraph (c) of Section 1302, which shall read as follows:

- (c) Burn-through time for all component wall assemblies shall be a minimum of 45 minutes, as tested by a nationally approved testing agency.

**SECTION 2.**

There is hereby added to Exhibit "A" of Washoe County Ordinance No. 83, Section 1402, which shall read as follows:

**Sec. 1402**

- (a) Buildings or parts of buildings classed in Group I because of the use or character of the occupancy shall be limited to the types of construction set forth in Tables No. 5-C and No. 5-D and shall not exceed, in area or height, the limits specified in Sections 505, 506 and 507.
- (b) Burn-through times for all component wall assemblies shall be a minimum of 45 minutes, as tested by a nationally approved testing agency.

**SECTION 3.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
