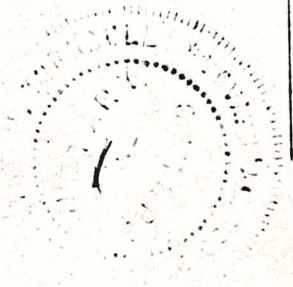

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Bill No. 45 was introduced before the County Commissioners of Washoe County at a meeting held on the 21st day of March, 1960 and by the said Bill No. 45 it is proposed that an ordinance be enacted entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE REGULATING THE INSTALLATION, ALTERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF WARM AIR HEATING SYSTEMS, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR WARM AIR HEATING INSTALLATION AND THE INSPECTION THEREOF, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH."

5 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE REGULATING THE
6 INSTALLATION, ALTERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF WARM AIR
7 HEATING SYSTEMS, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PER-
8 MITS FOR WARM AIR HEATING INSTALLATION AND THE IN-
9 SPECTION THEREOF, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLA-
10 TION THEREOF, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF
11 ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

12 THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF
13 WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

14 SECTION 1. That the 4th edition of the National Warm Air Heating
15 Code, adopted by the Sheet Metal and Air Conditioning Contractors
16 National Association together with such changes as are necessary
17 to make the same applicable to conditions in the County of Washoe
18 marked Exhibit "A" be and the same are hereby adopted as the code
19 of the County of Washoe for regulating the installation, altera-
20 tion and maintenance of warm air heating systems in the County of
21 Washoe and the regulations, conditions, provisions and terms of
22 said Warm Air Heating Code, 4th Edition, and Exhibit "A" on file
23 in the office of the County Clerk of Washoe County and the Washoe
24 County Building Inspector, are hereby referred to, adopted and
25 made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

26 SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
27 herewith are hereby repealed.

28 SECTION 3. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of
29 the provisions of this Code shall be deemed guilty of a misdemean-
30 or, and each such person shall be deemed guilty of a separate
offense for each and every day or portion thereof during which any
violation of any of the provisions of this Code is committed, con-
tinued or permitted, and upon conviction of any such violation
such person shall be punished by fine of not more than \$500, or by

1 imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both such fine
2 or imprisonment.
