ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A COUNTY BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT; ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS; THE TERMS OF OFFICE; THE MANNER OF APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS; THE MANNER OF REMOVAL AND FILLING VACANCIES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 103 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. The terms of office of members to the Board of Adjustment shall be for a period of four years, expiring on June 30th, or until their successor takes office, provided, however, terms of the first Board appointed after the effective date of this Ordinance shall be for 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 years."

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as prescribed by NRS 244.105.
