AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING, APPROVING AND CONFIRMING ACTION HERETOFORE TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE WASHOE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT, ITS OFFICERS, AND THE OFFICERS OF WASHOE COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH THE SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 28TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1961, AT WHICH THERE SHALL BE SUBMITTED THE QUESTION OF THE DISTRICT'S INCURRING AN INDEBTEDNESS IN THE MAXIMUM PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$6,000,000.00, FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING THE SCHOOL FACILITIES OF SAID DISTRICT, BY CONSTRUCTING NEW SCHOOL BUILDINGS, ENLARGING AND REPAIRING EXISTING SCHOOL BUILDINGS, ACQUIRING SCHOOL BUILDING SITES AND ADDITIONAL REAL PROPERTY FOR NECESSARY SCHOOL PURPOSES, AND PURCHASING NECESSARY SCHOOL EQUIPMENT THEREFOR; PROVIDING THE PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES TO BE USED FOR SAID ELECTION, AND THE APPOINTMENT OF INSPECTORS AND CLERKS THEREFOR, AND OTHER DETAILS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND AUTHORIZING THE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE WASHOE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE ACTION TAKEN HEREIN.

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board of Trustees of the Washoe County School District (herein sometimes designated as the "School Board" and the "District," respectively), in the County of Washoe and State of Nevada, has transmitted certified copies of the resolution adopted and approved by the School Board on the 14th day of September, 1961, to the County Clerk and to the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County (herein sometimes designated as the "County Board" and the "County," respectively); and

WHEREAS, NRS 387.360, as amended by section 268, chapter 157, Statutes of Nevada, 1960, provides, in subsection 2 thereof, that immediately upon receipt of a certified copy of the resolution calling a special school district bond election, the board of county commissioners and the county clerk shall perform the duties required by law for holding elections in the several counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, IN THE STATE OF NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That all action heretofore taken (not inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance) by the School Board, the officers of the District, and the officers of the County, directed toward improving the District's school facilities, by constructing new buildings, enlarging and repairing existing school buildings, acquiring school building sites and additional real property for necessary school purposes, and purchasing necessary school equipment therefor, be, and the same hereby is, ratified, approved and confirmed, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the adoption by the School Board of said resolution on the 14th day of September, 1961, and action taken pursuant thereto.

Section 2. That the polling places, precincts and precinct boundaries for said special school district bond election shall be the same as those designated for the general election held in the County on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 1960, except as heretofore and herein consolidated, changed and altered, which precincts and polling places are as follows:

Section 3. That at least thirty-one days preceding said special school district election, the County Clerk shall appoint and notify suitable persons who are registered voters in the County to act as election board officers for the various precincts and districts in the District, at least three such persons, two of which persons shall act as clerks of said election and the third of whom shall act as an attendant to admit registered voters to vote on a voting machine. Said inspectors and clerks shall be the election officers for said election, shall have charge of the ballots on the date of said election, and shall perform such duties in holding said election, and make due return thereof as required by the general election laws of the State of Nevada insofar as the same are not inconsistent with the provisions of title 34 NRS.

Section 4. That said school district election shall be conducted in the manner provided by said title 34, by said resolution, and as nearly as practicable in the manner provided for the conduct of general elections; and the County Clerk and his deputies shall do all things in connection with said election required by said title 34, as supplemented by said resolution of the School Board, and as nearly as practicable with the general election laws and to the extent not inconsistent with said title 34 NRS, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the providing of printed ballots, furnishing of the voting machines and any ballot boxes for the several precincts, and the procuring of any and all necessary materials, equipment and supplies, required by said laws; provided, however, that all expenses incurred in holding the special school district election shall be borne by the District, including but not limited to the expenses of printing necessary ballots and forms of affidavit, pursuant to NRS 387.360, as amended.

Section 5. That the County Clerk shall give notice of the action hereby taken by transmitting to the Clerk of the School Board a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication as hereinafter provided, and that after this ordinance is signed by the Chairman of said Board and attested and sealed by said County Clerk, this ordinance shall be published by title only, together with the names of the Commissioners voting for or against its passage, and with a statement that typewritten copies of said ordinance are available for inspection by all interested parties at the office of said County Clerk, in the Reno Evening Gazette, a newspaper published daily in the City of Reno therein, at least once a week for a period of two weeks by two insertions, pursuant to NRS 244.100, and all laws thereunto enabling, such publication to be in substantially the following form:
