SUMMARY: Amends Ordinance No. 134, changing the curfew hours, and other matters properly relating thereto.

BILL NO. 267

ORDINANCE NO. 134

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL FOR MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS TO LOITER OR BE IN PUBLIC PLACES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY BETWEEN CERTAIN HOURS, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR PARENTS OR GUARDIANS OF SUCH MINORS TO PERMIT A VIOLATION OF SAID CURFEW, PROVIDING CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS THERETO, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 134 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Section 1. Unlawful for Minors to Loiter; Curfew.

A. It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, or be in or upon the public streets, alleys, highways, roads or other public places in the unincorporated area of the County of Washoe at any time between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. of the following day, Sunday through Thursday, and between the hours of 12:00 Midnight and 5:00 A.M. of the following day, Friday and Saturday.

B. This Section shall not apply to any person:

- (1) Who is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having legal care, custody and control of such minor;
- (2) Who is on any lawful business, emergency or otherwise, or engaged in any lawful occupation;
- (3) Who is travelling under orders issued to him from any of the Armed Forces of the United States.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
