ORDINANCE NO. 194 (amends Ord. No. 105)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 105 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING LOCAL REGULATIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF VACATION PERIODS, HOLIDAYS, COMPUTATION AND AMOUNT OF SICK LEAVE AND COMPULSORY RETIREMENT AGES FOR EMPLOYEES OF WASHOE COUNTY AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 1 of the above-entitled ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Definitions.

As used in this ordinance:

- A. "Anniversary date" means one year from the date of hire, rehire, or most recent promotion.
- B. "Date of hire" means the date of original employment by Washoe County.
- C. "Employee" means:
  - 1. A public officer of the County of Washoe or its political subdivisions.
  - 2. Any person employed by the County of Washoe or its political subdivisions, whose compensation is provided by the county or its political subdivisions and who is under the direction or control of officers of the county or political subdivisions thereof.

"Employee" does not include independent contractors or persons rendering professional services to an employer on a fee, retainer or contract basis.

The Board of County Commissioners shall determine who are employees under this definition:

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
