SUMMARY: Prohibits cashing of personal checks from public funds by County officers and employees.

BILL NO. 326

ORDINANCE NO. 203

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING WASHOE COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES FROM CASHING PERSONAL CHECKS FROM PUBLIC FUNDS DRAWN BY COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES AND PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

It is unlawful for an officer or employee of Washoe County to cash from public funds, and he shall refuse to cash from public funds, any check drawn by a County officer or employee or by a private individual, whether or not there is reason to doubt that such check will be honored. This Section does not preclude the acceptance of personal checks in payment of exact amounts of obligations due Washoe County, but in no event shall such a check be accepted in an amount which requires the return to the drawer or endorser of cash constituting the difference between the amount owed Washoe County and the face value of the check.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
