NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 334, Ordinance No. 210, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing and directing the District Attorney of Washoe County to bring all appropriate civil actions in said District Attorney's discretion in any court of competent jurisdiction to enjoin, abate, or restrain the continued violation of any duly enacted or adopted ordinance, rule, or regulation of Washoe County which is designated as or otherwise constitutes a nuisance within the meaning of such ordinance, rule or regulation; authorizing any action filed pursuant to this ordinance to be brought in the name of the County of Washoe; specifying the power and jurisdiction of the Board of County Commissioners to control the prosecution or defense of any suit filed pursuant to this ordinance," was adopted on August 27, 1973, by Commissioners Rusk, Scott, Pagni, Nelson and Grow all voting aye.

SUMMARY: An Ordinance directing the District Attorney of Washoe County to file all necessary civil actions in the name of The County of Washoe to enforce any ordinance, rule, regulation, or uniform code having the effect of law in the unincorporated area of Washoe County.

ORDINANCE NO. 210

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF WASHOE COUNTY TO BRING ALL APPROPRIATE CIVIL ACTIONS IN SAID DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S DISCRETION IN ANY COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION TO ENJOIN, ABATE, OR RESTRAIN THE CONTINUED VIOLATION OF ANY DULY ENACTED OR ADOPTED ORDINANCE, RULE, OR REGULATION OF WASHOE COUNTY WHICH IS DESIGNATED AS OR OTHERWISE CONSTITUTES A NUISANCE WITHIN THE MEANING OF SUCH ORDINANCE, RULE OR REGULATION; AUTHORIZING ANY ACTION FILED PURSUANT TO THIS ORDINANCE TO BE BROUGHT IN THE NAME OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE; SPECIFYING THE POWER AND JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO CONTROL THE PROSECUTION OR DEFENSE OF ANY SUIT FILED PURSUANT TO THIS ORDINANCE.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County has decided, in view of the numerous uniform codes and rules and regulations incorporated therein that have been adopted by Washoe County ordinances, that it would be desirable to authorize the District Attorney of Washoe County, in accordance with the powers conferred on said Board by the Nevada Revised Statutes, to bring any necessary civil actions in courts of law to enforce said ordinances, rules and regulations.

SECTION 2.

Pursuant to the authority granted the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County in subsection 6 of NRS 244.360 added by the 1973 Nevada Legislature (Chapter 160 of Advance Sheets, Nevada Legislature, Fifty-Seventh Session), the District Attorney of Washoe County is hereby authorized to bring all necessary civil actions in his discretion in any court of competent jurisdiction on behalf of the County of Washoe to enjoin, abate, or restrain the continued violation of any duly enacted or adopted ordinance, rule, or regulation of Washoe County having the force and effect of law, including any rule or regulation contained within any specialized or uniform code and changes thereto adopted by a Washoe County Ordinance, such as, but not limited to the various volumes and editions of the Uniform Building Code, Uniform Plumbing Code, National Electric Code, Uniform Fire Code, Uniform Mechanical Code, Uniform Housing Code, and Uniform Sign Code, provided the violation in question is designated as or otherwise constitutes a nuisance within the meaning of the provisions of the ordinance, rule, regulation, or uniform code on which legal action is to be based.

SECTION 3.

All civil actions filed by the District Attorney of Washoe County pursuant to this Ordinance shall be brought in the name of The County of Washoe and signed by said District Attorney or his Deputy as attorney for said County.

SECTION 4.

Pursuant to NRS 244.165, the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County shall have the power and jurisdiction to control the prosecution or defense of all suits filed pursuant to this Ordinance.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
