ORDINANCE NO. 219

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING TYPICAL ROAD SECTION AND CUL-DE-SAC SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF COUNTY ROADS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. The specifications contained in Typical Road Sections drawings Sheets Nos. 1 and 2, dated April 21, 1966, and Typical Cul-de-Sac drawing Sheet No. 3, dated December 1967 and revised January 18, 1972, attached hereto as Exhibits A, B and C, respectively, are hereby approved and adopted for use in Washoe County.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication pursuant to NRS 244.100.

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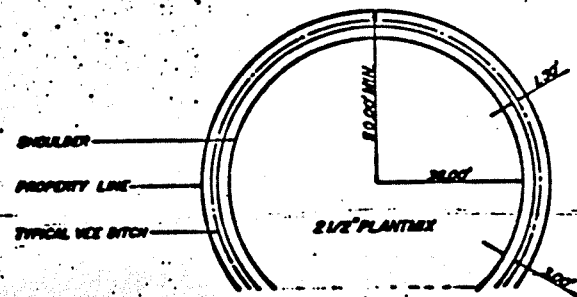
