SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 66 to authorize the Department of Public Works, subject to approval of the County Commissioners, to provide a uniform system of marking and signing streets and erecting signs and traffic control signals where necessary and providing for penalties for disobedience of instructions of said signs and signals.

BILL NO. 388

ORDINANCE NO. 233

AMENDS WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 66 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A UNIFORM SYSTEM OF MARKING AND SIGNING STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN WASHOE COUNTY, TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY CONNECTED THEREWITH."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Amends Section 1 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 66 to read as follows:

- (a) The Department of Public Works of Washoe County, subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners, is hereby authorized to provide a uniform system of marking and signing streets and highways within Washoe County and such system of marking and signing shall correlate with and so far as possible conform with the system adopted in other parts of the State of Nevada.
- (b) The Department of Public Works, subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners, is hereby authorized to determine the character or type and to place and erect upon the streets and highways traffic control signals at places where it shall deem them necessary for the safe and expeditious control of traffic. Insofar as practicable, all types of traffic control signs shall be uniform as to type and location.

SECTION 2.

Amends Section 2 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 66 to read as follows:

Signs, signals and markings.

- (a) The Department of Public Works, subject to the approval of the County Commissioners, shall cause appropriate signs to be erected and maintained, designating railroad crossings and such other signs and markings and traffic control signals as may be deemed necessary to direct and regulate traffic and to carry out the provisions of Chapter 484 of the Nevada Revised Statutes and county ordinances, and such additional signs as may be appropriate to give notice of parking and other regulations.

(b) Any signs, signals or markings authorized under this Ordinance shall not be effective with respect to highways constructed or maintained by the Department of Highways under the authority granted by Chapter 408 of the Nevada Revised Statutes until such sign, signal or marking has been approved by the Board of Directors of the State of Nevada Department of Highways.


SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.


