NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 428, amending Ordinance No. 226, adopting Ordinance No. 261, entitled "An Ordinance providing for the licensing and inoculation against rabies of dogs in designated congested areas of the unincorporated area of Washoe County; provides for special permits to maintain in excess of three dogs; prohibits dogs running at large or trespassing on private property; provides for the quarantine of biting animals; provides for the designation of a poundkeeper and the impoundment of animals found in violation of the provisions of this ordinance; providing for regulations for impoundment, destruction and release of animals; prohibits the keeping of noisy animals; provides penalties for non-compliance with the provisions hereof; and other matters properly relating thereto," was adopted on March 5, 1975 as an emergency measure by Commissioners Scott, Graw, Rusk, Nelson and Gaunt all voting aye.

SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 226 to require payment of annual licensing fee of \$ 4 per dog.

BILL NO. 428

ORDINANCE NO. 261

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND INOCULATION AGAINST RABIES OF DOGS IN DESIGNATED CONGESTED AREAS OF THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDES FOR SPECIAL PERMITS TO MAINTAIN IN EXCESS OF THREE DOGS; PROHIBITS DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE OR TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY; PROVIDES FOR THE QUARANTINE OF BITING ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A POUNDKEEPER AND THE IMPOUNDMENT OF ANIMALS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS FOR IMPOUNDMENT, DESTRUCTION AND RELEASE OF ANIMALS; PROHIBITS THE KEEPING OF NOISY ANIMALS; PROVIDES PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The first sentence of Paragraph C of Section 5 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 226 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Every person owning or having the care, custody or possession of a dog or dogs in the County shall pay to the Animal Control Officer an annual license fee of \$ 4.

SECTION 2.

The Board of County Commissioners finds that an emergency exists and pursuant to NRS 244.100, this ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and publication.
