ORDINANCE NO. 296

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASING AND CONTRACTS ADMINISTRATOR OF WASHOE COUNTY TO PREPARE RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING PURCHASING POLICIES, PRACTICES, AND PROCEDURES; PROVIDING FOR THE APPROVAL OF SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY; REPEALING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 159; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The Purchasing and Contracts Administrator of Washoe County is hereby authorized and empowered from time to time to prepare and propose to the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County rules and regulations regarding purchasing policies, practices, and procedures not in conflict with or inconsistent with the Nevada Local Government Purchasing Act or other applicable state statutes. Such rules and regulations and amendments thereto upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County shall be in full force and effect and shall be adhered to by every employee and officer of Washoe County.

SECTION 2.

Washoe County Ordinance No. 159, effective February 16, 1968, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
