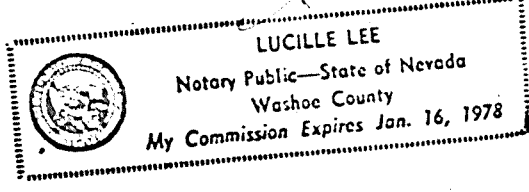

Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 470,
Ordinance No. 305, amending Ordinance No. 229, entitled
"An Ordinance regulating the use of County Park System
Facilities; designating the Washoe County Parks and
Recreation Department to administer the system; permitting
promulgation of rules and regulations to supplement the
provisions of the Ordinance; providing for payment of
fees; providing prohibitions and a penalty; and providing
other matters properly relating thereto," was adopted on
January 26, 1976 by Commissioners Scott, Grow, Rusk,
Nelson and Gaunt all voting aye.

SUMMARY: Amends ordinance regulating use of county park system facilities to accommodate maintenance duties assigned General Services Department.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 229 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF COUNTY PARK SYSTEM FACILITIES; DESIGNATING THE WASHOE COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO ADMINISTER THE SYSTEM; PERMITTING PROMULGATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS TO SUPPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF FEES; PROVIDING PROHIBITIONS AND A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 33 of County Ordinance No. 229 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 33. Handling objects, displays, historic units. No person other than park officers or employees of the department, or employees of the General Services Department, in pursuit of their official duties shall touch, handle or move any objects on display or exhibit.

SECTION 2. Section 35A of County Ordinance No. 229 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 35. Disturbance of conduits. No person shall:

- A. Excepting for employees of the General Services Department, in pursuit of their official duties, enter into, remain upon or disturb the conduits or artificial or constructed or plastic conduits transporting water to any county park.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
