NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 542, Ordinance No. 374,
entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT
OF COUNTY FOR EXPENSES INCURRED WHEN A CHILD IS
DETAINED, OTHER THAN PURSUANT TO A COURT ORDER,
IN A FACILITY FOR TEMPORARY DETENTION OF CHILDREN
OR OTHER COMMITMENT FACILITY ADMINISTERED OR
FINANCED BY THE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR LEGAL AC-
TION AGAINST THE PARENT, PARENTS OR GUARDIAN FOR
FAILURE OR REFUSAL TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY FOR
SUCH SERVICES," was adopted on April 11, 1978 by Com-
missioners Rusk, Nelson, Farr, Stoess and Brown.

SUMMARY: Provides for reimbursement of County for expenses incurred in temporary detention of children, other than pursuant to a court order; provides for action against parent, parents or guardians for failure or refusal to reimburse County for such services.

ORDINANCE NO. 374

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COUNTY FOR EXPENSES INCURRED WHEN A CHILD IS DETAINED, OTHER THAN PURSUANT TO A COURT ORDER, IN A FACILITY FOR TEMPORARY DETENTION OF CHILDREN OR OTHER COMMITMENT FACILITY ADMINISTERED OR FINANCED BY THE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR LEGAL ACTION AGAINST THE PARENT, PARENTS OR GUARDIAN FOR FAILURE OR REFUSAL TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY FOR SUCH SERVICES.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Reimbursement of County for Expenses of Temporary Detention of Children.

When a child is detained, other than pursuant to a court order, in a facility for the temporary detention of children or other commitment facilities administered or financed by the County for the detention of children, the Board of County Commissioners may collect from the parent, parents or guardian of such child all sums of money expended by the County for the care and support of the child during the period of his detention.

SECTION 2. Actions against Parent, Parents or Guardian. If the parent, parents or guardian fails or refuses to so reimburse the County, the Board of County Commissioners may recover from said parent, parents or guardian, by appropriate legal action, all sums of money due together with interest thereon at the rate of seven percent (7%) per annum.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after its proposal, passage and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
