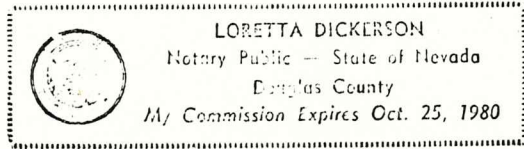

ORDINANCE NO. 415

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, PROPERTY AND SAFETY OF THE CITIZENS OF WASHOE COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, BY REGULATING TRAFFIC; PRESCRIBING MINIMUM STANDARD REQUIREMENTS IN REGARD TO TRAFFIC SUPPLEMENTARY TO STATE LAW; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH," BY ESTABLISHING A NEW SPEED LIMIT WITH RESPECT TO MOANA LANE.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
