ORDINANCE NO. 507

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION, FINGERPRINTING AND PHOTOGRAPHING OF PRIVATE POLICEMEN AND SECURITY OFFICERS AS DEFINED IN SAID ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND REVOCATION OF EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATES; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH" BY INCREASING THE SERVICE CHARGE FOR ISSUANCE OF AN EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATE AS A PRIVATE POLICEMAN OR SECURITY OFFICER.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 10 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 142 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 10. Application Required.

- A. An employee of a private policeman or security officer, before commencing such employment, must submit a written application on forms furnished by the Sheriff of Washoe County setting forth the applicant's personal history and containing his physical description. Information contained in the application is confidential and may not be released to any person except an elected county officer, the applicant's employer and peace officers.
- B. An applicant for employment as an employee of a private policeman or security officer must submit a nonrefundable service charge established by the Sheriff with the application to help defray the Sheriff's expense of investigating the applicant's background. An employee of a private policeman or security officer must also pay the service charge upon replacement or renewal of his employment certificate.
- C. An employee of a private policeman or security officer must be refingerprinted five years from the date of issuance of his employment certificate and every five years thereafter. The employee must pay the service charge established by the Sheriff for refingerprinting at the time he complies with the requirement contained in this Subsection.
