NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following bills were adopted on Tuesday, November 10, 1981, by Commissioners Farr, Ferrari, Brown, Underwood and Williams:

Bill No. 677, Ordinance No. 506, amending Ordinance No. 276, entitled "An ordinance creating county commissioner districts based upon population in Washoe County, Nevada, in compliance with the Local Government Reapportionment Law; and providing other matters properly relating thereto," by revising certain county commissioner districts to include partial assembly districts.

Bill No. 678, Ordinance No. 507, amending Ordinance No. 142, entitled "An ordinance requiring the registration, fingerprinting and photographing of private policemen and security officers as defined in said ordinance; providing for the issuance and revocation of employment certificates; prescribing penalties for violation thereof and providing other matters properly relating thereto; and repealing all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith," by increasing the service charge for issuance of an employment certificate as a private policeman or security officer.

Bill No. 679, Ordinance No. 508, repealing Ordinance No. 202, entitled "An ordinance authorizing the Washoe County Sheriff to issue permits to carry concealed weapons or to possess and transport any shell, cartridge, bomb, or weapon containing or capable of emitting tear gas, or any weapon designed for the use of such shell, cartridge, or bomb; establishing an application fee for such permits; providing for annual renewal thereof; providing for the revocation thereof; and providing other matters properly relating thereto."

Bill No. 680, Ordinance No. 509, amending Ordinance No. 226, entitled "An ordinance providing for the licensing and inoculation against rabies of dogs in designated congested areas of the unincorporated area of Washoe County; provides for special permits to maintain in excess of three dogs, prohibits dogs running at large or trespassing on private property; provides for the quarantine of biting animals; provides for the designation of a poundkeeper and the impoundment of animals found in violation of the provisions of this ordinance, providing for regulations for impoundment, destruction and release of animals; prohibits the keeping of noisy animals; provides for the impounding of all dogs endangering private or public property, public safety, themselves, or other animals; provides penalties for non-compliance with the provisions hereof; and other matters properly relating thereto," by increasing the fees for dog licenses and for replacement of lost dog tags; and by prorating the fee for such licenses.

Bill No. 681, Ordinance No. 510, amending Ordinance No. 458, entitled "An ordinance regulating the keeping of exotic animals in the unincorporated area of Washoe County; establishing standards for enclosures in which such animals are kept; creating the Exotic Animal Advisory Board; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto," by increasing the fee for an exotic animal permit.

Bill No. 682, Ordinance No. 511, amending Ordinance No. 1, entitled "An ordinance adopting the provisions of state law for the establishment, maintenance and operation of law libraries, setting fees to be set aside on the commencement in, or removal to, the District Court of Washoe County of any civil action, proceeding or appeal, and authorizing the Board of Trustees of said Law Library to do all things necessary to establish and maintain said library, and other matters properly pertaining thereto," by increasing the amount of filing fees to be set aside for maintenance of the Law Library.

Bill No. 683, Ordinance No. 512, amending Ordinance No. 229, entitled "An ordinance regulating the use of county park system facilities; designating the Washoe County Parks and Recreation Department to administer the system; permitting promulgation of rules and regulations to supplement the provisions of the ordinance; providing for payment of fees; providing prohibitions and a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto; by changing the method of adopting fees for using County park facilities.

Bill No. 684, Ordinance No. 513, amending Ordinance No. 243, entitled "An ordinance regulating excavations in public streets and alleys; providing for the issuance of permits therefor; providing technical specifications for the replacement and repair of streets after excavations; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto," by requiring a permit for street cuts on improved areas adjacent to County roads, streets or alleys and by raising fees for inspections made after street cuts.

Bill No. 685, Ordinance No. 514, entitled "An ordinance authorizing the County Treasurer to collect personal property taxes; providing for other matters properly relating thereto."

Bill No. 686, Ordinance No. 515, amending Ordinance No. 319, entitled "An ordinance adopting the 1978 edition of the National Electrical Code, together with such changes as are necessary to make the same applicable to conditions in Washoe County and such other changes as are desirable, relating to general provisions, wiring methods and materials, equipment for general use, special occupancies, equipment and conditions and communications systems; providing penalties for the violation thereof; repealing County Ordinance No. 84 as amended; and providing other matters properly relating thereto," by increasing service fees for issuing permits and making inspections.

Bill No. 687, Ordinance No. 516, amending Ordinance No. 83, entitled "An ordinance regulating the design, erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, conversion, demolition, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area, maintenance, excavation and foundation of any building or structure in the unincorporated area of Washoe County; providing for the issuance of permits, collection of fees, and administration of the Uniform Building Code incorporated herein; providing a method for the classification and abatement of any unsafe and dangerous building or structure within the unincorporated area of Washoe County; adopting requirements for insulation occupancies; providing the parameters of thermal design calculations to be made thereunder; providing penalties for the violation of any regulation adopted herein; and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith; and other matters properly relating thereto," by increasing service fees for issuing permits, checking plans and making inspections.

Bill No. 688, Ordinance No. 517, amending Ordinance No. 86, entitled "An ordinance of Washoe County providing for the protection of the public health and safety by prescribing minimum standards for the use, design, installation and maintenance of heating, ventilating, comfort cooling and refrigeration systems and equipment; requiring a permit and inspection for the installation, alteration and replacement of said equipment; providing for the administration and enforcement of such requirements; prescribing penalties for violations thereof; and other matters properly relating thereto," by increasing service fees for issuing heating, cooling and ventilation permits under the Uniform Mechanical Code.

Bill No. 689, Ordinance No. 518, amending Ordinance No. 324, entitled "An ordinance in the County of Washoe regulating the installation, alteration, and maintenance of plumbing and drainage systems and water distribution and sewer systems; providing for the issuance of permits for said plumbing and installation work and the inspection thereof; providing penalties for the violation thereof; repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith," by increasing service fees for issuing permits and making inspections.

Bill No. 690, Ordinance No. 519, amending Ordinance No. 132, entitled "An ordinance imposing a county motor vehicle fuel tax; creating a Regional Transportation Commission and prescribing its organization, powers and duties; providing for the mode of enforcement of the provisions hereof; providing penalties for non-compliance with the provisions hereof; and providing other matters properly relating thereto" by increasing the County excise tax on motor vehicle fuel to four cents per gallon effective January 1, 1982.

Bill No. 691, Ordinance No. 520, entitled, "An ordinance creating the South Truckee Meadows General Improvement District for the purpose of furnishing water, sanitary sewer, and storm drainage facilities." 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SUMMARY: Increases excise tax on motor vehicle fuel.

BILL NO. 691

ORDINANCE NO. 520

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A COUNTY MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL TAX; CREATING A REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AND PRESCRIBING ITS ORGANIZATION, POWERS AND DUTIES; PROVIDING FOR THE MODE OF ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO" BY INCREASING THE COUNTY EXCISE TAX ON MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL TO FOUR CENTS PER GALLON.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 5 of Ordinance No. 132 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. Imposition of Tax.

A. Imposition and rate of tax; statement of motor vehicle fuel sold, distributed or used.

(1) In addition to any other taxes provided by law, every dealer shall, not later than the 25th day of each calendar month render to the Department a statement of all motor vehicle fuel sold, distributed or used by him in Washoe County, as well as any motor vehicle fuel sold, distributed or used in this County by a purchaser thereof upon which sale, distribution or use, the dealer has assumed liability for the tax thereon under section 2 D. of this Ordinance, during the preceding calendar month; and pay an excise tax of four cents per gallon on all motor vehicle fuel so sold, distributed or used, in the manner and within the time prescribed in this Ordinance.

(2) The Department, for good cause, may extend, for not to exceed thirty (30) days, the time for making any report or return required under this Ordinance. The extension may be granted at any time if:

(a) A request therefor has been filed with the Department within or prior to the period for which the extension may be granted; and

(b) A remittance of the estimated tax is made when due. Any dealer to whom an extension is granted shall pay, in addition to any delinquent tax due, interest at the rate of one half of one percent per month, or fraction thereof, from the date on which the tax would have been due without the extension to the date of payment.

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(3) Any report, return, remittance to cover a payment, or claim for credit or refund required by this Ordinance which is transmitted through the United States mail, shall be deemed filed or received by the Department on the date shown by the post office cancellation mark stamped upon the envelope containing it, or on the date it was mailed, if proof satisfactory to the Department establishes that such document or remittance was timely-deposited in the United States mails properly addressed to the Department of Taxation.

(4) For the purpose of this Ordinance, motor vehicle fuel is sold where it is delivered into a vehicle not belonging to the seller or into a stationary tank on the premises of the buyer.

B. Imposition of excise tax on other inflammable, combustible liquids.

(1) In addition to any other taxes provided for by this Ordinance, every person who shall use any inflammable or combustible liquid or other material other than motor vehicle fuel as defined in Section 2 I. of this Ordinance to operate a motor vehicle on the highways of this State, except special fuel as defined in Section 2 I. of this Ordinance, shall pay an excise tax as provided by subsection A. of this Section for each gallon thereof so used, and shall render monthly statements and make monthly payments at the times and in the manner prescribed for dealers in this Ordinance.

(2) Any owner or operator of a motor vehicle who shall import motor vehicle fuel or other fuel or material, except special fuel as defined in Section 2 I. of this Ordinance, into this County, from another state or from Federal Proprietary lands or reservations, in the fuel tank or tanks of any such motor vehicle in a quantity exceeding twenty-five (25) gallons shall, upon demand of the Department or its duly authorized agent, pay to said Department on such excess motor vehicle fuel the excise tax required to be paid by dealers under this Ordinance.

(3) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to require more than one payment of any excise tax upon, or in respect to, the same fuel.

SECTION 2

The County motor vehicle fuel tax imposed by this ordinance shall be effective on the 1st day of January, 1982.
