SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Code by creating the Senior Citizens Center Department and prescribing the powers and duties of the Director.

BILL NO. 852

ORDINANCE NO. 678

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY CREATING THE SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER DEPARTMENT AND PRESCRIBING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR OF THAT DEPARTMENT.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Chapter 45 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 3, inclusive, of this ordinance.

SECTION 2.

45.300 Senior citizens center department; creation. There is hereby created the senior citizens center department.

SECTION 3.

45.310 Director: Position created; powers and duties.

1. The position of director of the senior citizens center department is hereby created. The director shall be appointed by the board of county commissioners upon the recommendation of the county manager and serves at the pleasure of the board.

2. The director shall direct and supervise the operations of the senior citizens center.

3. The director shall, with the approval of the county manager, appoint such technical, clerical and operating staff as are determined to be necessary for proper operation of the department.

4. The director shall adopt and enforce rules governing the use of the senior citizens center. Those rules must be consistent with the applicable County Facility Use Policy Statement, except that fee schedules may be established by the director and approval for use of the senior citizens center is within the discretion of the director.

5. The director shall act as the contract administrator for contracts which relate to the senior citizens center.

6. The director shall submit an annual budget to the board in the same manner as is required for other department heads.


