The County will make reasonable efforts to send all email comments received by 4:00 p.m. on July 14, 2021, to the Committee prior to the meeting.

The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.
