## **Utility Water and Sanitary Sewer Financial Assistance Program**

## BID ITEM CHECKLIST FOR SANITARY SEWER CONNECTIONS

Contractor's bids and proposals to abandon a private septic system and connect a customer to the public sewer system should provide and/or address the following items to be considered responsive:

- 1. Contractor's business name, contact person, address and phone number should be clearly listed:
- 2. Contractor's license number;
- 3. Length of sewer lateral, size and type of material;
- 4. Trenching
- 5. Bedding / backfill material;
- 6. Is a waste backwater valve necessary?
- 7. Quantity and locations of cleanouts;
- 8. Pump septic tank prior to abandonment;
- 9. Abandonment to include slurry / sand / collapse and/or removal;
- 10. Landscaping repair as necessary (may include sod, concrete, fencing, etc.)
- 11. Permits required:

  - b. Washoe County Utility sewer lateral permit Please contact Utility Customer Service at (775) 954-4601 for permit information; an application for sewer service will also be required.
