Based upon the results of the discussions with Department Heads and County staff, the Board of County Commissioners will discuss and give direction to staff regarding Washoe County's strategic priorities, key outcomes, success indicators, supporting goals, and action plans for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 and Fiscal Year 2007-2008.
