Unless otherwise indicated by asterisk (*), items listed below are items upon which direction may be given to staff; however, no final action will be taken on any item.

*Public comments - three-minute time limit per person. The Commission reserves the right to reduce the time, or limit the total time allowed for public comment, if more than 10 people request to speak.

The purpose of the Retreat is to discuss and possibly give direction regarding vision, values, philosophy, procedures and/or priorities of the Washoe County Commission, which may include, but not be limited to, issues such as:

- Board Relations, including Board member to Board member relations, Board meeting procedures, board to staff relations, and board to community relations
- Vision and Values of the County Organization, including role of the County, core businesses of the County, and the role of the Board
- Emerging Trends and Issues, and implications for Washoe County's strategic priorities, including, but not limited to:
 - Demographic changes
 - Community priorities
 - County services and functions, including distribution of services and equity among commission districts, incorporated and unincorporated areas
 - Infrastructure, including facilities and technology
 - Natural resources management, including water, land use, open space
 - Consolidation of government services
 - Regional governance
 - Financial resources
 - Citizen involvement and participation
 - Staff and volunteer resources
- The Washoe County Budget and long term financial stability of the County
