12. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT CASE NO. CP03-010 AND LDC03-0030 - SKY VISTA PARCEL E.

- A. An amendment of the Reno-Stead Corridor Joint Plan to reconfigure the boundary of the Reno-Stead Joint Planning Area to exclude 3.45 acres on the southwestern boundary currently within the joint plan and to include a \pm 1-acre portion of the developed North Valleys Regional Parks Complex. The entire park would be designated Park and Recreation. The boundary reconfiguration would establish Sky Vista Parkway abutting the Sports Complex as the western boundary in that portion of the Reno-Stead Joint Plan. APN 550-020-18 and 550-020-22.
- B. And, if approved, direct the Mayor of the City of Reno and the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners to execute a Resolution to the Reno-Stead Corridor Joint Plan following a finding of conformance with the Regional Plan by the Truckee Meadows Regional Planning Commission. Further, if approved to direct the Commission Chair to execute the resolution for the North Valleys Area Plan following a finding of conformance with the Regional Plan by the Truckee Meadows Regional Planning Commission.
