1. Presentation and discussion of reports concerning Financial Trend Monitoring System and Ten-Year Financial Forecast; reports on Trends and Factors utilized in the establishment of Fiscal Year 2002/2003 Budget; and, discussion and direction on Fiscal Year 2002/2003 and Fiscal Year 2003/2004 Budgets.
2. Discussion and possible action with regard to Board communications, Rules and Procedures for the 2003 Washoe County Board of Commissioners.
3. Discussion and identification of short and long-term key strategic issues affecting Washoe County and Washoe County Government; and, possible direction to staff for same.
4. Discussion and possible direction to staff regarding Washoe County government priorities for Fiscal Year 2003-2004, and long-term priorities (beyond 2004), both of which may include, but are not limited to, priorities related to:
 - Financial goals and practices
 - Levels of service and service delivery alternatives
 - Major public works projects
 - Capital expenditures
 - Staffing and process improvements for functions and services provided by Washoe County government
 - Intergovernmental cooperation and consolidation efforts.
