



H1N1 (Swine Flu) Public Vaccination Clinic

The Sierra Fire Protection District will be offering a free H1N1 public vaccination clinic for all Sierra Fire District residents. Firefighters will provide vaccinations for all high-risk residents (see below for additional details). The District has approximately 500 doses available and will be provided on a first come, first served basis. Both injections and nasal spray will be available (limited quantities). High Risk Persons Include:

- Pregnant women
- Persons who live with or provide care for infants aged <6 months (e.g. parents, siblings, and daycare providers)
- Health-care and emergency medical services personnel
- Persons aged 6 months- 24 years old
- Persons aged 25-64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications.
