

## How Long Is A Permit Good For?

Your building permit is good for 18 months (one and a half years) from its date of issuance.

If you have not completed the project before this time is up, you can renew your building permit for an additional 18 months for a calculated fee. You are able to renew your permit a total of three times (giving a total of 6 years to complete your project) before it expires.

Also, renewal of a permit is prohibited if the work authorized by a permit is not commenced within the first 18 months after issuance or if any permit is not renewed within six months after expiration. A new plan/permit submittal will be required at that time.
