




Highlight of Activities January 1, 2022 to July 31, 2022

Rebuilding Together Northern Nevada accepts applications online, applications made via the telephone and hard copy applications. The chart below shows the status of the applications in process as of July 31, 2022. RTNNV has a total of 38 clients in the pipeline at the various stages as compared to 28 clients at the end of June 2022.



In calendar year 2022, Rebuilding Together has served a total of 38 households with site visits, and repair work complete or in progress. The following charts show stats for the 38 households served.






Average Repair Cost for Calendar 2022 = \$5,264 per household

In Fiscal Year 2022, RTNNV spent \$126,658 in direct repair costs including contractual repairs and supplies.

This figure would be much higher without the tremendous help of our volunteers.

The households served this calendar year have received repairs via the Safe at Home, Critical Repair programs, Community and National Rebuilding Day. The following chart shows the type and number of repairs completed this calendar year.
