SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR APPROVAL FOR funding for the purchase of First Due

software suite that will interconnect CAD data, routing for responding resources, pre-incident planning, and high-risk occupancy data management for the Sparks

Fire Department in an amount not to exceed \$27,000.00.

SUMMARY

The Sparks Fire Department is requesting funding for the purchase of software that will interconnect our CAD data to a suite of applications that will enhance the information available to responding resources.

BACKGROUND

The First Due software suite is already in service for the Reno Fire Department and the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District. The software increases safety for responders by linking several databases together and sending live information to responding resources. With Sparks Fire Department joining the application, all three regional partners will be utilizing the same platform, therein increasing interoperability and information sharing between the jurisdictions.

Several years back, staff reviewed the product but chose to yield due to the high volume of new applications hitting the market. First Due has held through the times and continued to grow their product. Regional partners report satisfaction with the product features including linked CAD data, response routing, pre-incident planning, and community engagement through the community connect platform. This product has enhanced emergency response with improved information sharing for responder, citizens, and businesses in our region. Currently, the City of Sparks Fire Department seeks approval to join with our regional partners to improve upon the delivery and safety of our emergency service delivery to our community.

NRS APPLICABLE

NRS 244A.7645 proved approval of costs associated with maintenance, upgrade, and replacement of equipment necessary for the operation of the enhanced telephone system.

Stakeholders are the City of Sparks Fire Department.

PREVIOUS ACTION

The First Due software suite has previously been approved for the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District (Jan 21, 2021 – E911 Advisory Committee Meeting), and the Reno Fire Department (May 20, 2021 – E911 Advisory Committee Meeting).

FISCAL IMPACT

The Enhanced 911 Fund is a special revenue fund which receives revenue pursuant to NRS 244A.7643 in the form of telephone surcharges collected to support the emergency reporting system. Budget authority exists within the E911 Fund to support the automated size-up, preincident planning and high-risk occupant related data management software subscription. The total cost for the subscription is \$27,000.00.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the E911 Emergency Response Advisory Committee approve the request for funding for an automated size-up, pre-incident planning, and high-risk occupant related data management software subscription for the City of Sparks Fire Department, in an amount not to exceed \$27,000.00.
