

Proposed Code: Highlights **Tiered Permitting System** • Tier 1: 10 occupants or fewer; standard STR permit ■ Tier 2: 11-20 occupants; discretionary permit • Tier 3: 21 or more occupants; only in areas where hotels/motels allowed; commercial standards apply STR Permit: Similar to privileged license Revoke without Board action; renew annually; no guarantee of renewal **6**

Decibel-monitoring devices for problem STRs

Parking

One parking space for every 4 proposed occupants
All parking must be developed onsite (including to TRPA standards, if applicable)

External Placard
While rented: Display 8.5 x 11" with STR permit #, hotline #, responsible party #, and max occupancy
