COVID-19

Vaccines and testing remain available to inmates upon request/presentation of symptoms.

- During this reporting period, there were 29 cases of Covid-19 in the jail.
- There are currently no active cases of Covid-19 in the jail.

Washoe County Detention Facility Health Risk

- Fentanyl issues in the jail were identified through investigations and observation.
 - Suspects charged with PCS for Sales and related charges.
 - During this reporting period (Jan-Mar), there were 8 suspected overdoses. 2 of those cases were "other" medical emergencies.

Welfare of the Inmates

- We graduated 11 inmates through "Getting Ahead while Getting Out" in March.
 - This program is designed to offer inmates basic life skills.
 - Inmates who were fortunate enough to complete this program, earned one college credit through TMCC.
 - By graduating the program, the inmates earn a "5-day kick" that saved the County \$7,770 dollars.

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Fotal cost savings through all program classes was \$48,840 dollars.

Staffing Update

- The jail currently has no deputies in the Field Training Program. 155 deputies are on-line, with another 5 on light duty status for various reasons.
- WCSO currently has 20 deputy trainees in the NNLEA, with a completion date projected for June .
 - 25 deputies completed their FTO program and began working the line.
 - Detention continues to transfer deputies to patrol to assist both valley and Incline staffing numbers.
