Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers.

Forum Restrictions and Orderly Conduct of Business. The Safety Committee conducts the business of Washoe County and its citizens during its meetings. The presiding officer may order the removal of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive comments or behavior may or may not be given prior to removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.

Responses to Public Comments. The Safety Committee can deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. During the public comment period, speakers may address matters listed or not listed on the published agenda. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly prohibit responses to public comments by the Safety Committee. However, responses from the Safety Committee to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. On the advice of legal counsel and to ensure the public has notice of all matters the Safety Committee will consider, the Safety Committee may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for County staff action or to ask that a matter be listed on a future agenda. The Safety Committee may do this either during the public comment item or during the following item: "Topics for Future Agendas".

2. Public Comment

There was no response to the call for public comment.

3. For possible action, a review and approval of the Washoe County Safety Committee meeting minutes of September 16, 2021.

Cathy Hill made a motion to approve and accept the September 16, 2021, minutes, seconded by Ben West, motion passed unanimously.

Open Issues

4. Review and Discussion of Industrial Injury Summary Reports and recommendations of the Committee for prevention of work-related injuries or illnesses.

Celeste Wallick directed the Committee's attention to pages 6 through 13 of the report and pointed out that there were 23 claims for the month of September with very few that can be fixed. Committee members inquired as to the validity of claims and their status. For the claims in question Celeste explained that claims can be denied however they are counted in the State's report. Specific information was asked regarding the claims involving hydrogen sulfide.

No recommendations were offered by the committee.

5. Discussion and possible action of Code 65 updates

Ben West stated he was following up with Deputy District Attorney Mary Kandaras on code updates. He will follow up with her again.

6. For possible action, a discussion, and recommendations on the update of COVID-19 activities and safety concerns

Celeste Wallick stated that there was no new activity to report from her. Ben West stated that patrons of the libraries continue to not follow the policies on mask wearing.

7. For possible action, a review of the communication summary from Ben West

Ben West stated that he released information regarding ice and another communication during the week of Street Vibrations went out regarding motorcycles. He will release the penguin walk information next week.

8. For discussion, a report received regarding the homeless activity at County libraries

Cathy Hill informed the Committee about an email she received from a concerned citizen stating that there is a serious issue with the homeless population and a County librarian encountering a homeless individual sleeping with a hatchet under his head. Cathy Hill wanted the Committee to be aware of this email and allow Ben West the opportunity to discuss the issue with the downtown Reno library. Ben West informed the Committee that he is working with the Library Director on the issue and will be changing signage at the library. The current signage references Reno municipal code that the Sheriff's are not able to enforce. Special nighttime patrol from Allied will occur for about a week to enforce and educate the law regarding loitering.

Deputy Vander-Heyden stated she will also pass this information onto the Sheriff's HOPE team to assist the homeless.

9. Discussion and possible action on recommendation of safety award nominations

There were not recommendations for this meeting.

Cathy Hill stated there are no new events scheduled for the end of the year. Celeste asked the Committee to think of a project that they'd like to do in 2022.

Celeste Wallick stated that the departments have been performing their own drills. Ben West will seek direction from upper management on the desire for performing drills.

Kellisa Shirane introduced herself as the replacement for the Health District representative Victoria Nicolson-Hornblower. She responded to the COVID-19 activities of the Health District with testing activities continuing at the POD location by the Reno Sparks Livestock Events Center. The vaccinations will stop on December 17, 2021, and will be brought into the clinic on December 20, 2021.
