## 4. Election of New Chair

Dave Kelly thanked the new and existing SWS Board Members for their time and service. Dania Reid, DDA requested the board nominate a new chair. A motion was made by Mr. Carnes "Motion to nominate Mr. Buehler as the new Chair." Second by Mr. Adams, motion carried. 5. Approval of Agenda – May 5, 2022

Chair Buehler moved to approve the agenda of the May 5, 2022, Sewage, Wastewater, and Sanitation Board (SWS Board) regular meeting. Second by Mr. Adams, motion approved.

- 6. Approval of Draft Minutes September 3, 2019 Since the only board member present on May 5, 2022, was Matt Buehler and staff, Mr. Kelly created an agenda item to confirm staff verified the minutes to be accurate. Mr. Buehler moved to approve the minutes of the September 3, 2019, Sewage, Wastewater, & Sanitation Board (SWS Board) regular meeting. Second by Mr. Adams, motion approved.
- 7. Hearing Variance APN 230-101-07- Section 0.0100 Staff Representative: Ellen Messinger-Patton

Ms. Messinger-Patton provided an overview and stated that the Health District recommends the Sewage, Wastewater and Sanitation (SWS) Hearing Board support the presented Variance Case H22-0001VARI (M&T Land Holdings LLC) to allow the approval of portions of a septic system (WBLD21-104161) with less than the required 25' setback to a drainage channel. The variance requests a building sewer line be allowed to cross a storm drainage channel. The building sewer will be sleeved with 6" SDR35 pipe, anchored with concrete and installed 1' below the lined drainage channel. She further stated that none of this protrudes into the drainage ditch (below) and that WCHD has allowed this in the past with variance and will be recommending it be allowed when the regulations are updated.

Mr. Adams stated his company has done this exact system before with 4" SDR in 6" SDR35 pipe. He recommended installing warning tape at least one foot above the 50' sleeve for these crossings. Suggested clean-out green markers even though nobody wants to see markers.

Michael Vet, Engineer for the crossing project stated they would be extending a 25' sleeve on both sides so probably 60 feet total. This may address your concern as the crossing is five feet underneath the driveway and will require an engineer sign off for the septic system. Crossing will be underneath the drainage pipe. This is in a flood zone and everything is already elevated so all water is being directed away from the project.

Chair Buehler expressed concern about future changes. Dave Kelly stated as-builts are required with any changes and WCHD has 98% of records on all Washoe County properties. EHS runs into this frequently. Last two variances were similar and crossed irrigation ditches. Intent of reg changes will be a minor risk to public health and larger issues will still come before the SWS Board.

## **Conditions of Approval**

- 1. Any instances of system non-function must be reported to WCHD for review and shall be repaired immediately. In the event of failure to maintain or lack of system function, WCHD may require sampling and/or impose restrictions on the property based on the functionality of the septic system, up to and including removal of the drainage channel crossing.
- 2. Require recording of the variance to the parcel to ensure proper public records notification in the event the property is sold to any other person or entity. Recording may not be removed without Health District approval.

Motion made by Chair Buehler "Move to present to the District Board of Health a recommendation for approval of Variance Case H22-0001VARI (M&T Land Holdings LLC) to allow the approval of a septic system as proposed, including all recommended conditions which includes DTAC tape over the entire 50-foot surrounding area." Second by Mr. Carnes, motion approved. Chair Buehler closed the public hearing.

8. Hearing - Variance for APN 222-073-04 section 040.100 Table 2 Staff Representative: Josh Philpott

Mr. Philpott provided an overview and stated that the Health District recommends the Sewage, Wastewater and Sanitation (SWS) Hearing Board support the presented to update and provide any direction from the Board on the Environmental Health Services Division's (EHS) review of the submitted variance application for your decision to recommend or deny approval to the District Board of Health (DBOH) a variance for APN 222-073-04 which is owned by Michael & Julie Dianda. The variance requests the allowance of a building sewer line to cross an existing hard piped storm water drainage channel. The building sewer line would be concrete encased from the point of crossing, extending to 5 feet on both sides of the crossing. The building sewer line will run above the drainage channel with a minimum vertical separation of 6 inches.

Discussion and questions with Ryan Simms and Roy Haliburton with Q&D Construction regarding other options considered. Currently has SDR35 PVC pipe for lot drainage (rain only) so no possibility of debris blockage. Pipe is in a non-traffic load area.

Mr. Adams stated that it is one pipe over another like the first variance reviewed earlier in the agenda. No further concerns or discussion.

### **Conditions of Approval**

- 1. Any instances of system non-function must be reported to WCHD for review and shall be repaired immediately. In the event of failure to maintain or lack of system function, WCHD may require sampling and/or impose restrictions on the property based on the functionality of the building sewer line, up to and including removal of the storm drain crossing.
- 2. Require recording of the variance to the parcel to ensure proper public records notification in the event the property is sold to any other person or entity. Recording may not be removed without Health District approval.

### <u>Motion</u>

Motion made by Chair Buehler "Move to present to the District Board of Health a recommendation for approval of Variance Case H22-0002VARI (Michael & Julie Dianda) to allow the approval of a septic system as proposed, including all recommended conditions which includes DTAC tape over the entire 50-foot surrounding area." ### SUMMARY

This staff report summarizes the Environmental Health Services Division's (EHS) review of the submitted variance application for your decision to recommend or deny approval to the District Board of Health (DBOH) a variance for APN 552-084-06, owned by Sergio Quezada & Maria Reyes. The variance requests permission to install a septic system on an undeveloped parcel where municipal sewer is available within 200 feet.

### **Previous Action**

There has been no previous action with this variance request. The parcel in question will be served by community water.

### **Background**

The variance correctly identifies the Washoe County Health District (WCHD) Regulations Governing Sewage, Wastewater, and Sanitation (regulations) that prohibits the issuance of a permit to install a septic system if public sewer is available within 200 feet from the property line of an undeveloped parcel. After consultation with Washoe County Utilities and City of Reno, an available sewer line is in E. Golden Valley Road, approximately 40 feet from the SW corner of Mr. Quezada and Mrs. Reyes' property.

The property owners wish to build a dwelling on the property and while a test trench has not been performed on the parcel, it appears to WCHD staff that sufficient space exists on the property for a standard septic system and/or sand filter bed and associated future repair area, meeting all applicable setbacks required by the current code.

The only reason for the variance request is due to the proximity of the sewer line, which prohibits WCHD from issuing the necessary permits for the dwelling. Mr. Quezada and Mrs. Reyes are contending that the cost for dragging the sewer line to his property is cost prohibitive.

### **Findings of Fact**

The Board must consider the following when making a recommendation on this variance to the DBOH:



1. Will the proposed variance result in contamination of water to the extent it cannot be used for its existing or expected use?

**Reply:** The proposed systems would be able to meet all relevant setbacks that a normal system would and should not pose any additional threat to groundwater. There is no expectation of groundwater contact expected based on the original sizing of the system; However, if groundwater were encountered at depths, WCHD would require an appropriate re-design and believes space is available for any necessary modifications to protect groundwater should it be encountered.

2. Will the proposed variance pose a threat to public health?

**Reply:** There are two primary ways that sewage can pose a threat to public health, direct exposure via surface and groundwater contamination in areas with domestic wells. All sewage would be discharged underground preventing direct exposure and as all setbacks and design requirements are met, no increased risk of groundwater contamination is expected.

3. Are there other reasonable alternatives?

**Reply:** WCHD regulations do not allow for the issuance of any permit to install, modify or replace a septic system with municipal sewer available within 400 feet. There is no alternative other than for the property owner to drag the sewer line from E. Golden Valley Road to his property.

### **Conditions of Approval**

1. WCHD is not recommending any conditions of approval at this time, as the property is of sufficient size for a standard septic system or a sand filter bed that will meet all applicable setbacks. WCHD would follow its normal permitting and inspection procedures and if groundwater or other limiting layers were encountered would require the appropriate redesign. If the Board does determine that there are appropriate conditions of approval, any conditions they set should be required to be recorded to the title, not to be removed without Health District approval.

### **Recommendation**

Staff is neutral as to whether the Sewage, Wastewater and Sanitation (SWS) Hearing Board should support the presented Variance Case # H23-0001VARI (Sergio Quezada & Maria Reyes) to allow for the construction of a septic system to support a new dwelling, as all setbacks should be able to be met and the relative cost of dragging sewer to the property is the only issue. Our primary reason for remaining neutral is due to EHS's internal policy that financial hardship situations are not to be decided at the staff level but rather at the Advisory Board and District Board of Health level to avoid any personal judgements as to what constitutes a financial hardship.

- "Move to present to the District Board of Health a recommendation for approval of Variance Case # H23-0001VARI (Sergio Quezada & Maria Reyes) to allow the permitting and construction of a septic system as proposed, with the following conditions (list conditions)"; OR
- 3. "Move to present to the District Board of Health a denial of Variance care # H23-0001VARI (Sergio Quezada & Maria Reyes)".

The SWS Board may also formulate their own motion or request additional information from the applicant if desired.





Dear David & Latricia,

Along with my wife Maria and our family, I am requesting a variance from Washoe County in order to be able to install a septic system on my lot at 8900 Spearhead Way.

Over the last few years, I have been trying to work with the County to determine a cost-effective solution to hooking up to the municipal sewer, but have been unable to do so. I have received two estimates from civil contractors, both of which are nearly three times my purchase price of \$100,000. In speaking with the County, the sewer main in E Golden Valley Road is at a depth of 17' which would require special shoring for the trenches. Additionally, traffic control for working in E Golden Valley Road is also extremely expensive.

I have also reached out to my neighbors to see if they would be interested in participating in sharing the cost of extending the sewer main up Spearhead Way, but all of my neighbors are content with their septic systems and have no desire, nor the budget, to switch to municipal sewer.

In preparation for a septic system, I have engaged a civil engineering firm and am prepared to have them perform a percolation test, as well as a complete septic system design, including a sand-filtered system if necessary.
