

# Washoe County Diapering Procedures For Child Care Centers

## 1. Gather supplies:

- Disposable liner (optional)
- Gloves (optional)



#### 2. Carry child to changing table

- Avoid contact with soiled clothing
- Always keep one hand on child



## 3. Unfasten soiled diaper



## 4. Clean child:

- Use disposable wipes
- Front to back



## 5. Fold the used diaper over and secure it with tabs.

• If gloves are worn, pull the gloves inside out over the secured diaper as the gloves are removed.



## 6. Dispose of all soiled/dirty materials in a receptacle:

- With a lining
- With a tightly fitting lid
- Used for diapering materials only
- Kept out of reach of children



#### 7. Wipe hands (Caregiver and child)

• With a disposable wipe



## 8. Apply skin care ointments as needed.

- Put onto a clean, single service, disposable item (like tissue or Qtip) prior to application.
- Individual ointment must be labeled with child's name!




#### 9. Diaper child/baby:

- Slide clean diaper under buttocks
- Adjust and fasten
- Re-dress



## 10. Wash the child's hands with soap and water:

 May use disposable wipes if child is developmentally unable to wash their own hands





#### 11. Clean and sanitize

- Diaper changing table after each use
- Dispose of table liner, if used



#### 12. Wash your hands!! (Caregiver)



#### 13. Document:

- Any skin problems
- Any rash on the child
- Unusual stool frequency, color, or odor



#### 14. Report above to parent or guardian at pick up
