Just as these individuals followed through with their case managers and accomplished their housing goals, we look forward to supporting many successful exits this new year.

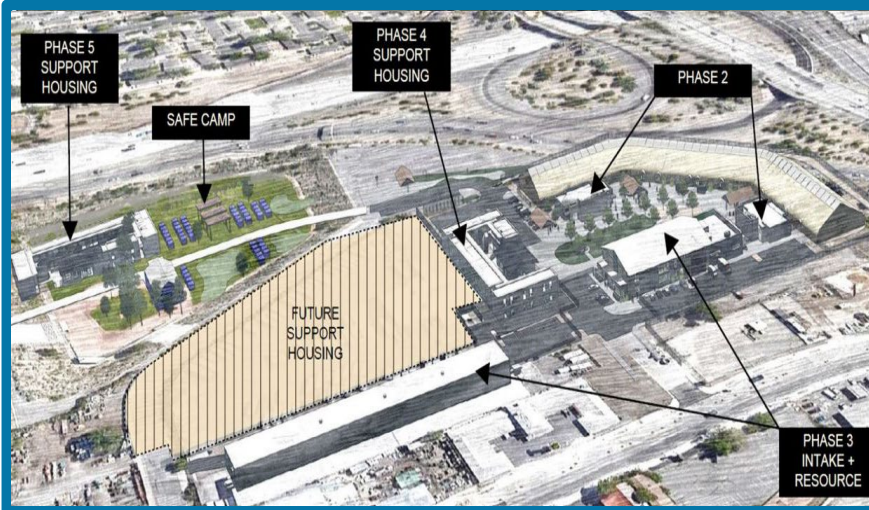
One successful exit we would like to share came from immediately addressing the needs of two brothers, making their stay on Campus rare and brief. During a recent snowstorm, two brothers arrived at the Cares Campus. They shared that they had just walked for 10 days from Bend, Oregon, attempting to get back home to San Antonio, Texas. The brothers had reached out to other programs for guidance to get home but were unable to secure the support needed. After arriving at the Cares Campus, staff immediately began working with the brothers on a plan to get them home. A sister was reached in Texas who was more than happy to provide a safe place for the brothers to live. Cares Campus staff engaged local resources and the brothers were able to return home.

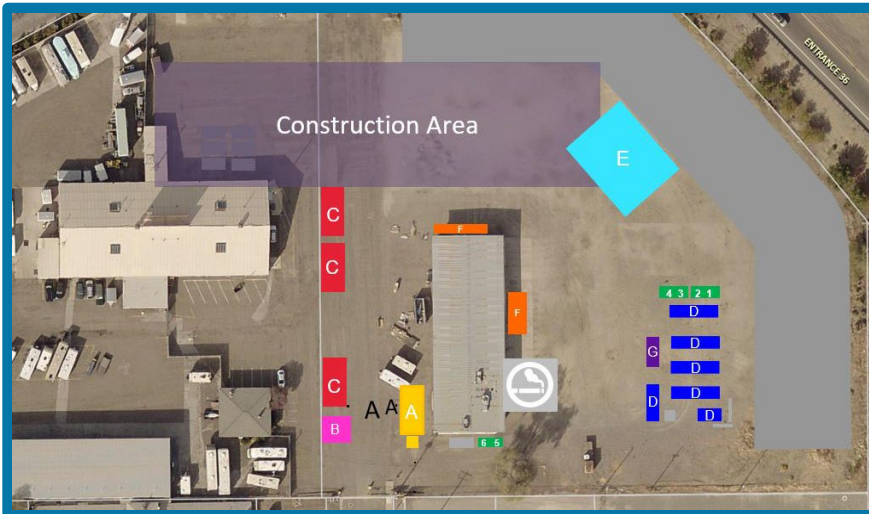
