

WASHOE COUNTY SUBSEQUENT INJURY PROGRAM

The Nevada Department of Industrial Insurance Regulation offers the Subsequent Injury Fund to all employers. This fund helps defray the costs of an industrial injury for employers who hire individuals with a prior, permanent physical impairment.

There are certain requirements which Washoe County must meet to qualify our employees for this added insurance coverage. The program involves any person who has a birth defect, work-related injury, or disease which has resulted in a permanent physical impairment. The following statement must be completed in detail as to the dates, cause, and extent of any physical impairment, signed by the employee and filed with the employee's personnel file.

ALL EMPLOYEES ARE REQUIRED TO READ AND SIGN THE STATEMENT TO PROPERLY DOCUMENT THEIR EMPLOYEE FILE.
