The purpose of the LEPC is to facilitate and accomplish comprehensive emergency response planning for hazardous materials and terrorism related incidents, accidents or releases; involve state and local government and private industries in developing and exercising emergency plans; work with the State to maintain a database; provide local residents access to information and improve public safety capabilities to respond.

LEPC MEMBERSHIP:

Each member has only one vote. Member representative may submit written proxy votes or allow a designated alternate to vote on his/her behalf. By signature of this Agreement, members must adhere to attendance requirements, as outlined in the By-laws, or be subject to replacement. Names of members are provided to SERC annually.
