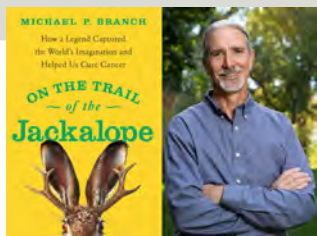

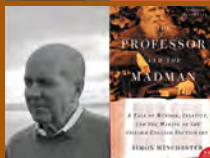

Books Unite Us. Censorship Divides Us: Celebrating Banned Books

with Debi Stears, Collection Development Manager



Each September librarians, publishers, authors, and readers of all ages join together to celebrate the freedom to read. The American Library Association's Office of Intellectual Freedom annually tracks and reports challenges made to materials in libraries. In 2021 the Office of Intellectual Freedom tracked 729 challenges in school, public, and university libraries, targeting 1,597 individual titles. This is the highest number of challenges in the 20 years of tracking, and a most disturbing trend.

Banned Book Week reminds us to take time to look at books that have been challenged across our nation and to reflect on what is lost when these books are removed from shelves and made unavailable to readers. As the effort to remove books from libraries has become more coordinated and more political, we see challenges targeting books that deal with racial inequality and LGBTQIA+ issues. When groups sound the alarm that a title is inappropriate or even dangerous, they typically pick out isolated passages or illustrations as proof of why the title should not be available to readers. We actively make these titles available to our community so that you can read the work in its entirety and form your own decisions about the value of the book as a whole.

At Washoe County Library we staunchly defend your right to read. We actively curate a collection of materials that reflects both the needs and interests of our wonderfully diverse community. As you browse through our collection of materials, you'll notice a wide variety of viewpoints and experiences, some reflecting experiences like your own and others that reflect a new idea or perspective. Our collection is always growing and changing to meet new interests. We intentionally don't take sides on an issue but instead provide a range of viewpoints so that you can explore and make your own decisions. If you've searched our collection and find that we've come up short, let us know by filling out the "Request an Item" form in our library catalog and our selectors will do their best to add new titles.

We're ready and willing to help you select just the right book for you or your child. Our staff can show you tools like *Novelist Plus* to help you find a book that matches your reading style or helps you find a new author. You can connect with other readers at one of our branch book discussions. And don't forget to tune in to KUNR Mondays and Tuesdays to hear staff share some of their favorite books in our *On the Shelf* and *On the Kid's Shelf* radio segments. Happy reading!

The History and Culture of the Washoe Peoples

This presentation will provide an overview of the history and culture of the Washoe Tribe.
