Our Summer Reading Challenge has ended, and this year we had 2,265 readers log almost 800,000 minutes of reading. Now that the school year is in full swing, the library is busy providing resources and support for students and learners of all ages as part of our core services.

September is Library Card Sign-up Month, so what better time to get or replace your library card? Visit any branch, or apply online to gain full access to Washoe County Library's services. It's fast, free, and easier than ever. And this year, there are even more ways to use your card. With new Library To Go book kiosks, our homebound delivery service, and a new bookmobile coming soon, you can look forward to more opportunities to access our collections and resources.

In addition to great resources for students (including after-school homework help at the newly-renovated Sierra View Library), the fall Explorer is full of opportunities for seniors, teens, kids, and readers of all ages. Don't miss TeenTober, a wide selection of Story Times, virtual author events, and the Celebrate Neurodiversity series with author Tiffany Hammond. Cultural events this fall include partnerships with the UNR Performing Arts Series, the Nevada Historical Society, Pioneer Center, and the Reno Chamber Orchestra.

Banned Books Week is October 1-7. This year's theme, Let Freedom Read, reminds us all that libraries everywhere support your freedom to read. Don't miss the feature by our own Collection Development Manager on page 5 for an overview of this important function of Washoe County Library. If you are looking for new book recommendations, you can catch me every month on the KOLO 8 Book Club. You can also hear me and many of our book-loving library staff each week on KUNR with our On The Shelf and On The Kids' Shelf segments. On our website, you can sign up to receive recommendations right to your email, or browse our many curated book lists on the #WhatToRead tab.

A partnership with Washoe County to take advantage of E-Rate funding from the FCC to bring a high-speed broadband fiber connection to the Gerlach Community Library, our most remote location, was completed in August. This exciting project will immediately offer a huge boost to connectivity for library, schools, and public safety entities. The new infrastructure will allow stable, high speed internet access for the community in the Gerlach region. And with the Sierra View Library renovation complete, we are continuing to make improvements to our spaces, including new accessible family restrooms at the Downtown Reno Library.

All of us here at Washoe County Library want you to have the best library experience possible, and we all appreciate your support as we work to make it better every day. Follow us on social media and subscribe to our weekly newsletter to make sure you don't miss anything, and be sure to let us know what you love and if there's anything we can do to better meet your needs.

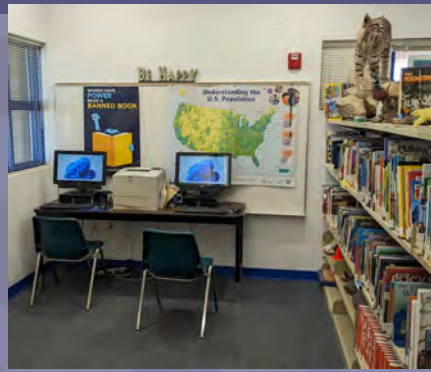

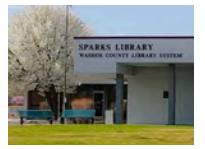

pick one up today at any Washoe County Library location!

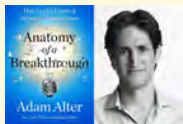

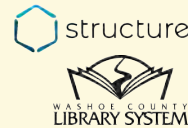

Exercise Your Right to Read with Debi Stears, Washoe County Library Collection Development Manager

Each fall, librarians, publishers, authors, and readers of all ages join together to celebrate the freedom to read. The American Library Association's Office of Intellectual Freedom annually tracks and reports challenges made to materials in libraries. In 2022 the Office of Intellectual Freedom tracked 1,269 challenges in school, public, and university libraries, targeting 2,571 individual titles. This is the highest number of challenges in the 20 years of tracking and a most disturbing trend.

Banned Books Week reminds us to take time to look at books which have been challenged across our nation and to reflect on what is lost when these books are removed from shelves and made unavailable to readers. Our community's children lose the ability to see themselves and families that look like theirs reflected in the books they read; parents lose the opportunity to engage in teachable moments with their kids; and readers of all ages lose the ability to explore the world around them.



At Washoe County Library we staunchly defend your right to read. We actively curate a collection of materials that reflects the needs and interests of our wonderfully diverse community. As you browse through our collection of materials, you'll notice a wide variety of viewpoints and experiences, some reflecting experiences like your own and others which reflect a new idea or perspective. Our collection is always growing and changing to meet new interests. We intentionally don't take sides on an issue but instead provide a range of viewpoints so that you can explore and make your own decisions. If you've searched our collection and find that we've come up short, let us know by filling out the "Request an Item" form in our library catalog and our selectors will do their best to diversify our selection of titles.

We're ready and willing to help you select just the right book for you or your child. Our staff can show you tools like NovelList Plus to help you find a book that matches your reading style or helps you find a new author. You can connect with other readers at one of our library book groups. And don't forget to tune in to KUNR Mondays and Wednesdays to hear staff share some of their favorite books in our "On the Shelf" and "On the Kid's Shelf" radio segments. Happy reading!
