

Overarching Recommendations

- Community partners need to use a system built upon evidence-based practices to ensure homelessness is rare, brief, and non-recurring
- CoC leadership needs to transfer from a contracted consultant to a local jurisdiction to increase the community's coordination and investment in the homeless service delivery system
