



Staffing Levels






Clients Served is the number of unique individuals who stayed at Cares Campus per month. Bed Nights shows the total number of bed night stays at Cares Campus.



Unduplicated Clients Served






Individuals staying at Cares Campus by race. Other includes null responses, client does not know, data not collected, and client refused.

Individuals staying at Cares Campus by Age Group.






Successful exits left the Cares Campus and went into stable housing.

Successful exits left Safe Camp and went into stable housing.


