April 2015 Highlights

- April is historically a busy month for volunteer events with the start of spring and Earth Day
 activities. Several groups volunteered at various parks this month including: Starbucks,
 Patagonia, Wells Fargo, Cabelas, Hidden Valley HOA, and several UNR Fraternities. Event
 sites included Hidden Valley, Crystal Peak, Bartley Ranch, Davis Creek, and Rancho San
 Rafael.
- The KNPB Explore the Outdoors event held in partnership with Washoe County at Rancho San Rafael Park was very well attended with approximately 3000 visitors estimated throughout the event. Parking ran smoothly thanks to a collaborative effort between parks staff and Rancho San Rafael's adopting fraternity Theta Chi. Shift of volunteers covered the entire event to make sure event participants and other park guests knew where to park. A crew of Theta Chi volunteers also helped with park cleanup before and after the event.
- Parks staff partnered with an Environment Studies class at Truckee Meadows Community
 College to work with students for 15 hours on a project related to the environment. The students
 then wrote a paper to describe their project and the environmental impact. Students volunteered
 at Lazy 5 Regional Park, at the Galena Creek Visitor Center, and with Park Planner Cheryl
 Surface. We look forward to a continued partnership in future semesters.
