## **South Region Highlights**

- Seasonal and temporary staff for operations have been hired and started working in late April.
- Davis Creek campground is fully opened for the season and is seeing an increase in use and revenue over the same time period as last year.
- All parks are seeing an increase in reservations and public use.

## **UPCOMING EVENTS**

- The KTMB community cleanup will occur on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Bartley Ranch Park, Crystal Peak Park, and Dorostkar Park will be work sites for planting and weed abatement.
- Hawkins Amphitheater will be hosting numerous events in May.
- Bowers Pool plaster repair will begin and plans are to open Memorial Day weekend.
- Bowers Mansion tours will begin on May 15<sup>th</sup>.

## **NORTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS**

- Seasonal and temporary staff for operations have been hired and most of them started mid April.
- A volunteer Pasture clean up to remove excess pet waste was held at Rancho San Rafael on April 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Highland ditch came on April 19<sup>th</sup>, providing much needed irrigation to the Multi-use Pasture at Rancho San Rafael
- Reservations have increased greatly in most of our park facilities

## **UPCOMING EVENTS**

- The KTMB community cleanup will occur on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Rancho San Rafael, North Valleys Regional Park, and Lockwood Park will be work sites for planting and weed abatement.
- Rancho San Rafael will be hosting an Eco Blitz in conjunction with UNR on May 7<sup>th</sup> to study the biodiversity and ecological communities in several representative areas in the park.
- Silver State Striders will be hosting their annual 50/50 run at Rancho San Rafael. This is an endurance run that has 50 mile and a 50 kilometer options.
