SOUTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS

- Bartley Ranch Regional Park hosted Gardening In Nevada classes on Tuesday evenings in March. This is an annual event and held every Tuesday evening in February and March. The classes are presented by the University of Nevada Cooperative Extension.
- Bowers pool construction continued with the replastering and conversion of the baby pool to a splash pad.
