## **SOUTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS**

- Bowers Mansion Park hosted the Blue Grass Festival on August 19th and 20<sup>th</sup>.
  Attendance was over 500.
- Bowers Pool splashpad has been completed and the pool and splash pad will be open on weekends through September 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Ranger Andy Brown concluded the campfire programs at Galena Creek Park with an astronomy program with about 40 in attendance.
- Hawkins Amphitheater at Bartley Ranch Regional Park hosted the Sierra School of Performing Arts performance of Into the Woods on weekends in August.
