Widening gap Desired Services Funding

- Continued population growth in the Truckee Meadowspressure on existing facilities
- Regional and municipal facilities are deteriorating
- Lack of new facilities causing overcrowding and inequity of services; significant increase in demand
- Inability of governments to financially support maintenance of facilities; competition for resources
- Deterioration of our natural systems, ie., Truckee River Corridor



What's Changed, Why Now?

- Citizens' heightened awareness of deteriorating facilities
- 2013-City of Sparks Comprehensive Parks & Recreation Draft Plan
- 2019-Washoe County Parks & Open Space Master Plan Updated
- Anticipated Summer 2023-City of Reno Parks, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan Updated
- Prepare for the future



Why is a New Approach Needed?

- Opportunity to focus mutual efforts
- New governance tool to improve effectiveness, efficiency, accountability to citizens
- Region's population growth placing unmet demands on existing resources
- District model addresses capital <u>and</u> long-term operating needs-to tackle deferred maintenance issues
- Post Great Recession and COVID pandemic-economic recovery has not brought needed sustainable resources; competing interests for limited funds remains

How do we start the process in the Truckee Meadows?

- Initiated by citizens, Park Commissions or elected Boards of either a County and/or City
- Development and approval of a Service Plan with extensive citizen, business and community input
- Option to seek majority approval of affected property owners through election process

Service Plan Elements-Understanding the road ahead!

Financial feasibility analysis-outlining proposed services, financial structure, financing alternatives

Boundary mappopulation estimate and assessed valuation of properties within boundaries Facility, improvement, proposed projects listcost estimates, engineering services, proposed indebtedness, annual operation and maintenance expenses.



Intergovernmental Agreements-proposed agreements with adjacent governmental entities



Provides options-for a <u>sustainable</u> Regional Parks, Open Space, Trails and Recreation system



-The Mechanics-

District financing options

- Intergovernmental revenue-city, county, state & federal
- User Fees
- Rate assessments on identified parcels
- Property tax/ad valorem-(except in Washoe County which is capped); cannot double assess for existing funded services; requires approval of local County Board of Commissioners
- Contract services
- Grants/donations
- It cannot supplant existing funding-it fills the gap and provides for the future.

- Bend Metro Park and Recreation District-Bend, OR
- Bozeman Parks and Trails Special District-Bozeman, Montana (May 2020)

- General Improvement Districts- IVGID, SVGID
